## To complete the FAFSA application, you will need your:


- Your tax return
- Parents tax return (If required)
- W-2's from all of your Jobs
- Parent's W-2's (If required)
- IRSC School Code (001493)



# Verification

The FAFSA processing center determines who is selected for verification. It is required by the federal government and is intended to improve the accuracy of the information you provided when applying. Selection may be random or because your FAFSA data was incomplete, estimated or inconsistent.

Federal guidelines state that, if you are selected for verification and the tax filing status of the student and/ or parents is inconsistent with the marital status reported on the FAFSA, that will represent conflicting information that must be resolved before aid can be disbursed.





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For example, if the student and/or parents are married but have each filed as "head of household" or "single", then the taxes must be amended or a statement must be provided from the IRS with an explanation of why the taxes are able to be filed in that manner. Once the information is updated only then can the documents be processed by the financial aid office.



It's crucial that you provide verification documents as quickly as possible to ensure timely processing of your financial aid.

IRS Data Retrieval Tool





#### IRS RETRIEVAL TOOL

The IRS Data Retrieval Tool allows students and parents to access the IRS tax return information needed to complete the FAFSA, and transfer their income data directly from the IRS Web site.

#### WHY USE THE RETRIEVAL TOOL?

It's the easiest way to provide your tax data
It's the best way to ensure information is accurate
YOU WON'T NEED TO PROVIDE COPIES OF YOUR TAX RETURNS
NOR YOUR PARENTS' TAX RETURNS OR W-2'S TO YOUR
COLLEGE (as long as information is not changed).



#### Leaving FAFSA on the Web

You are now leaving FAFSA on the Web and will be transferred to the IRS Web site to access your IRS tax information. Your information will be saved and your FAFSA on the Web session will end.

Your saved FAFSA will automatically open either when you transfer your information from the IRS or choose to return to FAFSA on the Web from the IRS Web site. If you do not transfer your information or choose not to return to FAFSA on the Web from the IRS Web site, you will have to login to open your saved FAFSA.

Click OK to continue. Otherwise, click Cancel.


After the FAFSA is populated your IRS session will end and you will return to your FAFSA.

#### Do Not Transfer My Tax Information and Return to the FAFSA 1

By clicking the "Do Not Transfer" button, you are choosing not to transfer your tax information electronically. Your IRS session will end and you will return to your FAFSA. You may still use this tax information to input the data into your FAFSA.





#### Reasons that Data Cannot be Transferred Via IRS Link

- Students or parents are married but filed as "Married Filing Separately".
- Students or parents are married and filed as Head of Household
- You filed an amended tax return, or filed a Puerto Rican or foreign tax return
- You filed your return electronically within the last 2-3 weeks or through the mail within the last 8-11 weeks. In this case, we suggest you save your FAFSA and go back to use the retrieval tool at a later date (if you're not filing your FAFSA late)



## KEY POINTS TO REMEMBER

- Make sure your name and social security number matches what's on your social security card.
- Double check that your date of birth is correct.
- If you are an eligible non-citizen, make sure your alien registration number is correct.
- Parent's names and social security numbers must also be accurate.
- Complete asset information (even if the answer is 0)

Direct Subsidized Loans are loans made to eligible undergraduate students who demonstrate financial need to help cover the costs of higher education. The U.S. Department of Education pays the interest on a Direct Subsidized Loan:

- While you're in school at least half-time,
- For the first six months after you leave school (referred to as a grace period\*)
- During a period of deferment (a postponement of loan payments).

Direct Unsubsidized Loans are loans made to eligible undergraduate, graduate, and professional students. You are responsible for paying the interest on a Direct Unsubsidized Loan during all periods. .



# Federal Student Loans

Low Interest.

Based on eligibility not credit.

Awards can range from \$1000 to \$7500 depending on student status (freshman, sophomore, etc...) and dependency (dependent or independent student).



## 150% of Program for subsidized loans means....

If you start a two year program and use loans for half of it, but change to a different program, you only have one year of loan eligibility left.

Your loan eligibility increases if your program length increases – for example, going from a two year program to a 4 year program.

NOTE: Before making program changes, check with your financial aid office to see how your eligibility will be effected (if you are receiving loans).

# This may be the most important thing you see today!

In order to keep your aid, you MUST make Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP).



# SAP Rules (Summary):

You must keep a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better.

You must earn at least 70% of your attempted hours.

You cannot attempt more than 150% of the credits required for your degree program.



Dual enrollment courses are college credit and count towards SAP progress.



## IRSC offers more than 150 programs, including:

- Bachelor's degrees
- Associate in Arts degrees (university transfer)
- Associate in Science degrees (career training)
- Career Training Certificate Programs

Tuition is currently \$103.83 per associate level college credit and \$117.10 per baccalaureate level college credit based on Florida residency.



Tuition and fees at IRSC are 40 to 50% less than Florida State Universities and 80 to 90% less than private career institutes and colleges
